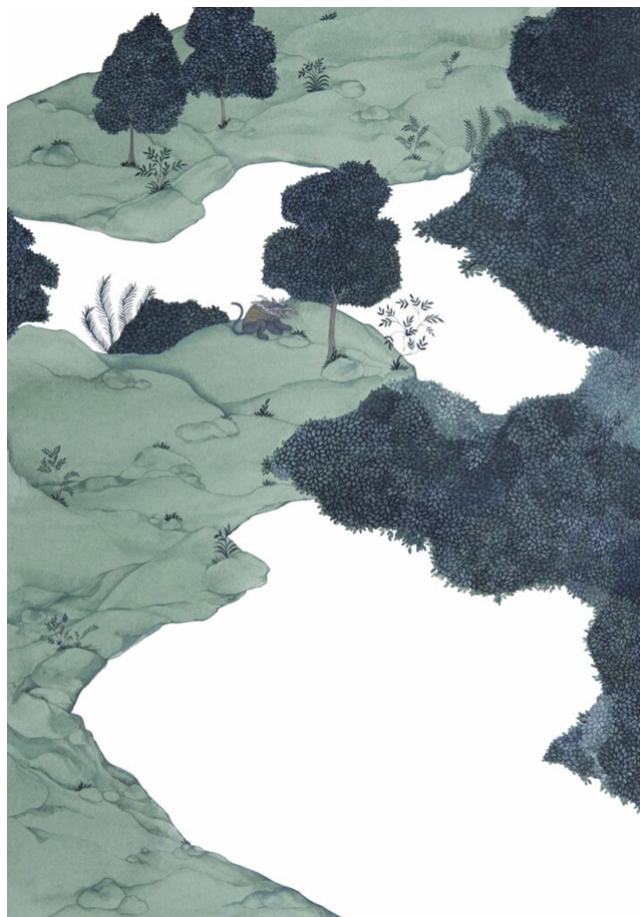

Gouache Mahi Ahmed

Artist **Maha Ahmed** was born in Pakistan, in 2012 received a bachelor's degree in miniature painting from the National College of Art in Lahore, and in 2015 a master's degree from London's St. Martins Central School of Art. Now she lives and works in Dubai. Mahi Ahmed's graphics are based on traditional Persian miniature painting and classic Japanese landscape techniques, in particular on the Yamato-e style (大 stile 絵). The result of the synthesis of the two cultures can be traced in a series of gouache painters written in 2017-2018. The works are executed in a restrained, almost monochrome color scheme, more inherent in Far Eastern art.
