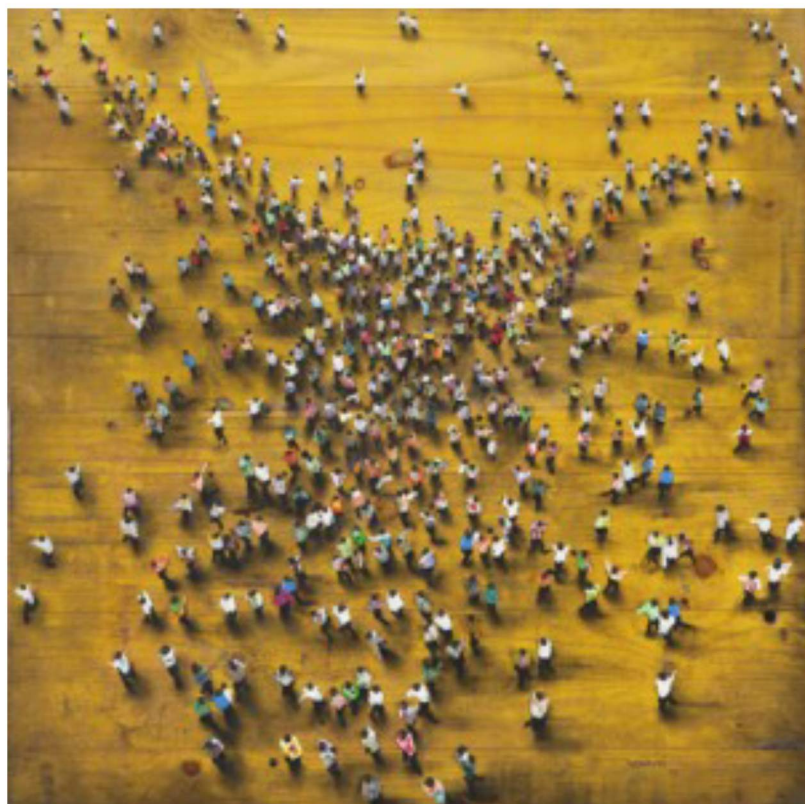


# Tabish's Top 5 Art Exhibitions to see in London this week
